FCA RECOVERIES & CASES AS OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2020



2020 VS. 2019



Recoveries down from \$3.1B in 2019 (28%)

922 new cases represent 17% increase vs. 2019


Of the 922 new cases, 672 originated from whistleblowers, and 250 originated from government-initiated investigations. The 250 represents a 69% increase vs. 2019.

PENDING RECOVERIES

The FY 2020 False Claims Act Recoveries do not include resolutions between the DOJ and two pharmaceutical companies relating to alleged opioid abuses that were pending as of the end of the fiscal year. These resolutions will total more than \$3 billion in recoveries, which will be captured in the FY 2021 statistics.


